### PLENVU FOR YOUR COLONOSCOPY PREP

#### DAY BEFORE PROCEDURE:

- 1. Drink only CLEAR LIQUIDS for breakfast, lunch and dinner. Suggestions below.
- 2. Starting anytime after 4:00 p.m., pour ONE (1) pouch of Plenvu into the mixing container. Add cool drinking water to the 16 oz. line on the container & mix. Drink all the liquid in the container. Expect MANY bowel movements to follow.
- 3. You must drink one (1) more 16 oz. containers of water or clear liquid over the next 1 hours. This is very important to avoid dehydration.

#### MORNING OF PROCEDURE:

Approximately 5-6 hrs prior to your procedure, repeat step 2 (with both  $2^{nd}$  dose pouches). Be sure you finish drinking all of the solution at least 4 hours before your procedure start time. Do not drink any more liquids other than the Plenvu in the morning. Typically, you will only have 1-2 bowel movements after the  $2^{nd}$  dose of Plenvu.

\*\*\*\*\* If you have a morning arrival time, you can take both doses of Plenvu the evening before:  $1^{st}$  dose at 4:00 p.m. and  $2^{nd}$  dose at 10:00 p.m. \*\*\*\*\*

#### CLEAR LIQUIDS ALLOWED:

Water, Gatorade, clear fruit juice, bouillon, broth, plain jello, popsicles, Italian ice, sprite, or coke. Coffee and Tea with sugar, hot or cold, but NO MILK OR CREAMER. No liquid with red dye. NO SOLID FOODS, MILK OR TOMATO PRODUCTS, OR ORANGE JUICE ALLOWED.

<u>Medications</u>: The day BEFORE the procedure, take your medications as you normally do. The day OF the procedure, we recommend taking the medications AFTER the procedure. Exception: If you are on blood pressure meds, please go ahead & take that medication as early as possible the morning of procedure with a *small* amount of water.

YOU WILL BE SEDATED AND WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO DRIVE AFTER YOUR EXAM.

PLEASE BE SURE SOMEONE IS WITH YOU TO DRIVE YOU HOME.
